
SUBJECT: Additional Information, Directions and Map for the Tour of the Potrero Hills Landfill on October 16, 2008

The field trip to the Potrero Hills Landfill on October 16, 2008 will begin at the entrance to the landfill at 2:00 p.m. and should take approximately 1½ hour. The tour will include a visit to the active landfill site and the proposed expansion site. The tour will likely involve getting off the buses to observe sites of interest. Therefore, all attendees should wear comfortable walking shoes with solid, flat soles and no open toes, and should dress appropriately for the weather, which is often windy.

For those planning to meet at Potrero Hills Landfill, directions to the landfill and a map are provided in the attached Special Meeting Notice. Below is information for Commissioners, Alternates and staff who have reserved space for bus transportation to and from the landfill site.

Bus Pick-up from BCDC Office in San Francisco

Passengers boarding the bus outside the BCDC office at 50 California Street, San Francisco, should meet at the California/Davis Street building entrance near the Bank of America ATMs, **no later than 12:15 p.m.** where BCDC staff will provide further directions. The bus will depart at 12:30 p.m. sharp. 50 California Street is a block away from the Embarcadero BART station and a short walk from the San Francisco Ferry Terminal. Parking is available in a garage under the building with entry off Sacramento Street, as well as in the Embarcadero Center. Below is a map of the pick-up location.



Bus Pick-up from Suisun City/Fairfield Train Station, Solano County

Passengers arriving by Amtrak at the Suisun City/Fairfield train station in Solano County should proceed directly to the bus marked “Potrero Hills Landfill” that will be waiting at the bus loading zone area to the right of the train station building and platform. The bus will **depart at 1:30 p.m.** to accommodate passengers arriving on the eastbound Capitol Corridor train at 1:23 p.m. At the conclusion of the landfill tour at 3:30 p.m., a bus will take passengers back to the train station to catch the 3:58 p.m. eastbound train and the 4:14 p.m. westbound train.
