Location: In the Bay, at the state and federally authorized San Pablo Bay (SF-10) disposal site, Marin County.

Description: Dispose of up to 7,000 cubic yard (cy) of maintenance dredged sediment at the San Pablo Bay (SF-10) disposal site over a 10-year period. The sediment originates from the Porto Bello Homeowners Association docks located in the San Rafael Canal, in the City of San Rafael, Marin County, which is located outside of the Commission's jurisdiction. The dredging project depth is minus 6 feet Mean Lower Low Water plus two foot of over-depth allowance, and is necessary to ensure safe navigation to the homeowners' berthing areas.
