**Location:** In the Bay (in a tidal marsh) and within the 100-foot shoreline band, on the south-side of Highway 37, in the Napa River Unit of the Napa Sonoma Marshes Wildlife Area, Solano County.

**Description: In the Bay**

Enhance drainage in a tidal marsh by installing a 50-foot-long, 24-inch-in-diameter pipe with a gate on both ends to connect a tidal ditch with an existing tidal channel.

**Partially in the Bay and partially within the 100-foot shoreline band**

Excavate two, 30-foot-wide breaches through two existing earthen berms to improve circulation in two tidal ditches.

Excavate, investigate, and repair a ten-foot section of petroleum pipeline that supplies fuel to the San Francisco Airport and other facilities.
