Administrative Permits and Federal Consistency Actions

Location: In the Bay, at the Port of Oakland Outer Harbor, Entrance Channel, and Oakland Inner Harbor channels, near the Port of Oakland, Alameda County.

Description: Conduct maintenance dredging over one year using clamshell bucket and scow to remove up to 802,000 cubic yards (cy) of sediment from Oakland Inner and Outer Harbor navigation channels to maintain navigational safety. Dredging is proposed to a project depth of -50 feet Mean Lower Low Water, plus an additional two feet of over dredge allowance. All dredged sediment would be beneficially reused by placing it at a contractor-provided beneficial reuse site, which will be determined prior to final dredge operation plan approval. In the event of a mechanical break down at the beneficial reuse site, up to 50,000 cy of sediment may be disposed at the San Francisco Deep-Ocean-Disposal site (SF-DODS). No in-Bay disposal of dredged sediment is proposed in this consistency determination.
