Location: In the Bay and within the 100-foot shoreline band, at Crissy Field (Park), north of Doyle Drive, in the Golden Gate Recreation Area, a park priority use area on Bay Plan Map No. 4, in the City and County of San Francisco.

Description: Replace an approximately 170-foot-long outfall with a new approximately 460-foot-long, 54-inch-diameter HDPE (High Density Polyethylene) outfall, approximately 270 feet of which would be buried beneath the beach and bay floor (the landward portion), and approximately 190 feet would be supported above the bay floor by approximately 16 HDPE piles, 13-inch diameter (the bayward portion). The buried pipe would be supported by eight HDPE piles, 13-inch diameter and 14 existing HDPE piles. The project would occur over an approximately 45,440-square-foot (1.04 acre) area.
