## DIRECTIONS

The meeting is one block from 12th St. (Oakland City Center BART station). We suggest using the BART 13th St. exit, walking through the City Center food court, and after crossing Clay St., enter the building via the North Tower to go through airport-like security (belt and shoes off).
