Lind Tug and Barge Inc Settlement Summary

- **Case summary:** Continued oyster shell mining after original permit expiration
- **Period covered:** 2012 to 2020
- **Settlement amount:** \$132,279 in 3 payments
- **Non-compliance penalty:** \$1,500 per violation

Chevron Settlement Summary

- **Case summary:** Deviations from dredge operation plan
- **Date reported:** February 2, 2021
- **Date settlement reached:** March 22, 2021
- **Settlement amount:** \$2,000
- **Preventative measures:** Procedural changes made to prevent recurrence

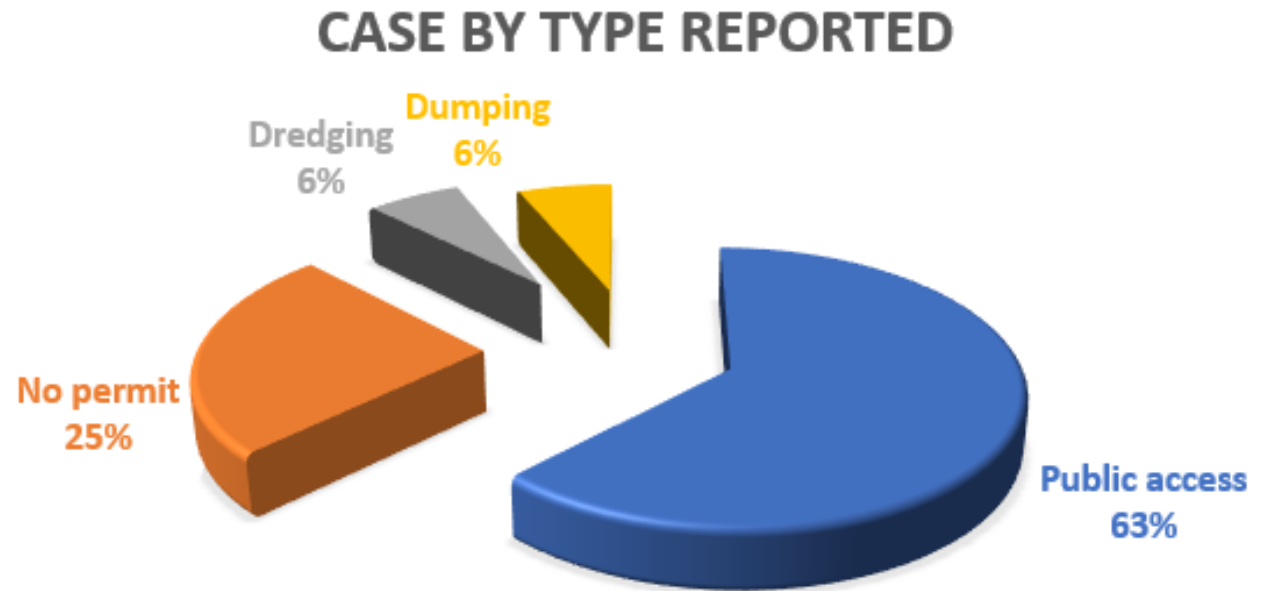
Mare Island Dry Dock Settlement Summary

- **Case summary:** Disposal of dredged material at unapproved location
- **Date reported:** January 28, 2021
- **Date settlement reached:** March 11, 2021
- **Settlement amount:** \$1,000
- **Preventative measures:** Procedural changes made to prevent recurrence

Standardized Fine Landry's Inc.

- **Case summary:** Public access area maintenance deficiency
- **Date 35-day notice issued:** January 14, 2021
- **Date fine determined:** March 7, 2021
- **Fine amount:** \$1,000
- **Preventative measures:** Ongoing maintenance
