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SUBJECT: Staff Report and Recommendation Concerning Amendments to Resolution No. 16 Describing the

Commission's Bay Plan Priority Use Area Boundaries

(For Commission consideration on April 20, 2023)

Staff Recommendation

The staff recommends that the Commission adopt the amended Resolution No. 16, describing Bay Plan priority use area boundaries.

Staff Report

Reason for the Proposed Resolution Amendment

As part of its responsibility to maintain and communicate its planning and regulatory jurisdiction, staff seeks Commission approval to make administrative amendments to Resolution No. 16.

The San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission's (BCDC) Resolution No. 16 fixes and establishes the boundaries of the Bay Plan priority use areas (PUA) within the Commission's 100-foot Shoreline Band jurisdiction, as required by the McAteer-Petris Act (California Government Code Sections 66602 and 66611). This amendment is intended to ensure that the published descriptions of PUA boundaries in Resolution No. 16 are current and accurate. There may be inaccuracies in the Resolution No. 16 descriptions for several reasons as further discussed below. The amendment does not modify the extent of existing PUA boundaries that are currently fixed and established by Resolution No. 16. The PUAs as designated in the Bay Plan will not change. In other words, the proposed amendment to Resolution No. 16 is simply a "clean up" to ensure the present-day accuracy of the descriptions of the boundaries of the Bay Plan PUAs set forth in the Resolution.

This Commission action will also facilitate another important goal – allowing BCDC to publish accurate maps of PUA boundary information through an online mapping application. This will create more transparent and accessible information about PUA boundaries to Bay Area communities and permit applicants, enable more efficient publishing of boundary updates as future Bay Plan Amendments (BPA) or substantive amendments to Resolution No. 16 occur, and advance BCDC goals of increasing regional understanding of BCDC's jurisdiction – all through a modern communication tool and platform.

Background

The McAteer-Petris Act provides that "certain water-oriented land uses along the bay shoreline are essential to the public welfare of the bay area, and that these uses include ports, water-related industries, airports, wildlife refuges, water-oriented recreation and public assembly, desalinization plants, upland dredged material disposal sites, and powerplants requiring large amounts of water for cooling purposes; that the San Francisco Bay Plan should make provision for adequate and suitable locations for all these uses, thereby

minimizing the necessity for future bay fill to create new sites for these uses; that existing public access to the shoreline and waters of the San Francisco Bay is inadequate and that maximum feasible public access, consistent with a proposed project, should be provided" (California Government Code Section 66602). As a result, the Commission has designated on the Bay Plan maps those areas which should be reserved for priority land uses on the Bay shoreline. PUAs currently represent areas designated for Ports; Water-related Industry; Waterfront Parks and Beaches; Airports; and Wildlife Refuges. The Bay Plan designates 103 PUAs around the Bay shoreline. The McAteer-Petris Act further provides in relevant part that: "No later than December 1, 1971, the Commission, after public hearing, of which adequate descriptive notice is given, shall adopt and file with the Governor and the Legislature a resolution fixing and establishing within the shoreline band the boundaries of the water-oriented priority land uses, as referred to in Section 66602" (California Government Code Section 66611). As a result, the Commission has fixed and established the specific boundaries of PUAs within the 100-foot shoreline band within which it is authorized to grant or deny permits for shoreline development. The specific boundaries of the PUAs within the shoreline band are set forth in Commission Resolution No. 16, first adopted in November 1971, and is amended over time to reflect amendments that modify the boundaries of PUAs within the shoreline band. Resolution No. 16 was last amended in January 2012. Although subsequent amendments to the Bay Plan have included resolutions to modify the boundaries of PUAs, these changes have not necessarily been memorialized in an amended Resolution No. 16 document since Resolution No. 16 is intended only to reflect the boundaries of PUAs within the shoreline band.

This amendment to Resolution No. 16 is to provide a current, accurate description of the boundaries of the existing PUAs within the shoreline band and does not remove or increase the size of any PUAs within the shoreline band. Because this amendment to Resolution No. 16 does not increase, decrease, or otherwise modify the scope of any of the existing PUAs within the shoreline band, Commission action to amend Resolution No. 16 as proposed is subject only to the requirement of a vote of a majority of the Commissioners present and voting (reference 14 CCR section 10241), rather than needing to be processed as a BPA in accordance with Government Code sections 66611 and 66652.

Staff has evaluated each PUA description in Resolution No. 16 to ensure that the boundaries perpendicular to the Bay and the 100-foot shoreline band are correct. Inaccuracies reflected in the current descriptions contained within Resolution No. 16, as amended, may be due to any number of reasons. For example, over time, many of the parcels used to delineate boundaries have changed, due to County Assessor renumberings, subdivisions, or other changes. Additionally, the names of agencies, landmarks, and streets may have changed and are out of date in Resolution No. 16. Finally, a number of minor grammatical changes have been made to provide consistency and clarity of boundary descriptions. Staff has reviewed ownership, current uses, general plan and zoning information to ensure the recommended changes to the PUA boundary descriptions within Resolution No. 16 accurately reflect "on-the-ground" conditions but also do not expand, reduce, or otherwise modify the extent of the existing PUAs as currently fixed and established in Resolution No. 16.

In addition to the review of the Resolution No. 16 descriptions, staff also confirmed the spatial representation of PUA boundaries that were previously digitized in Geographic Information System (GIS) data. Currently, permittees only have access to spatial representations of PUA boundaries in the static maps published in the Bay Plan. GIS PUA boundaries were originally created in 2012 by BCDC staff and have been used internally to help guide staff in permitting and planning work. Through this effort, the digitized GIS PUA boundaries were confirmed to be accurate with respect to the amended Resolution No. 16 descriptions, and no changes to the GIS PUA boundaries are proposed to be made that would materially alter the PUA. The confirmation of GIS PUA boundaries allows BCDC to confidently publish an interactive web mapping application to increase accuracy and accessibility of this information by the public. Additionally, the



publishing of GIS PUA boundaries will allow staff to more efficiently and accurately update Bay Plan maps when future BPAs modify PUA boundaries. The PUA web mapping application provides functionality to quickly search for a PUA, click the boundary of the PUA to see information like the PUA name, number, any previous amendments, Bay Plan map policies, and link to the amended Resolution No. 16 document. Users of the tool can also temporarily upload project GIS footprints and print simple maps to better understand if a project falls within a PUA. The web mapping application can be accessed directly at https://bcdc.maps.arcgis.com/apps/webappviewer/index.html?id=4d483c285a134740b315aadda38c8f62 and will be linked through the BCDC website and BCDC Open Data Portal. The GIS PUA boundary data will not be available for download at this time.

This work also serves the added benefit of helping advance the Commission's Strategic Plan. In particular, the confirmation of Resolution No. 16 descriptions helps to support Goal 1, Strategic Objective 1.5 "Review the Bay Plan for potential conflicts and compatibility between policies related to sea level rise, public access, and wildlife" by ensuring the geographic information describing the Commission's designated PUAs is accurate and up to date so that it can be used reliably in future analysis. Additionally, the online mapping platform contributes to Goal 4, Strategic Objective 4.1 "Develop engaging communications materials and tools that improve access to and understanding of BCDC's role and functions in the region" by making information about BCDC's jurisdiction more accurate, transparent, and accessible.

A longer-term goal of making PUA information more accessible to communities and staff is to increase awareness of BCDC's jurisdiction. This both serves to increase transparency of BCDC's existing authorities and highlights where tools such as the Bay Plan PUA designations may be improved and expanded to address emerging policy issues, such as climate adaptation.

Staff Analysis

Priority Use Area Designations

Within Resolution No. 16, PUA boundary descriptions within the shoreline band are as follows: one boundary is the shoreline of San Francisco Bay, one boundary is a line 100 feet inland from and parallel to the Bay, and the other two boundaries listed are the boundaries perpendicular to the shoreline and the line 100 feet inland. The Commission's policies are generally advisory as they pertain to PUAs inland of the shoreline band, except where an activity involves a federal entity or federal permitting or funding as provided by the federal Coastal Zone Management Act.

The amendments to PUA boundary descriptions are provided below. They only seek to amend descriptions based on changes to the "on-the-ground" conditions such as placenames, parcel numbers, and landmarks. None of the changes listed below seek to enlarge, reduce, or otherwise modify the scope of any of the Commission's Bay Plan PUAs as fixed and established by Resolution No. 16. If no amendments are recommended for a PUA, that will be indicated below.
