Maya McInerney (BCDC) will update the Working Group on background report materials and issue papers for stakeholder workshops.

2. Considerations for Beneficial Reuse of Sediment in Wetland Restoration Projects

Jeremy Lowe (San Francisco Estuary Institute) will present a regional perspective on wetland restoration and beneficial reuse of sediment and soils, and thoughts on how to prioritize this work.
