

MORE THAN 40,000 ACRES

More than \$150 million in land value donations

- Cargill helped launch the largest restoration project on the West Coast
- Cargill continues working with public agencies to safeguard wildlife habitat in its salt making
- **11,400 acres** for the Napa Sonoma Marshes Wildlife Area in 1994 and 2003
- **6,000 acres** for the Eden Landing Ecological Reserve in Hayward in 1996 and 2003
- **20,800 acres** for the Don Edwards San Francisco Bay National Wildlife Refuge and South Bay Salt Pond Restoration Project in 1979 and 2003
- **2,900 acres** transferred for open space, parks, environmental education and other public purposes, including 73 miles of Bay Trail



Cargill's Community Commitment

- Cargill provides 200 union and management jobs
